

## Abstract noun examples

Abstract nouns represent a wide variety of things—anything that isn't represented by a concrete noun, in fact. The table below explores a few different categories of things that abstract nouns can refer to.

### Examples of abstract nouns

<b>Personal qualities and emotions</b>	happiness, exhaustion, callousness, nostalgia, presumptuousness, loquacity, anger, love, charisma
<b>Time designations</b>	Tuesday, hours, the 1980s, centuries, midnight, yesterday, the future

<b>States of being</b>	<b>solidity, chaos, peace, vacancy, impermanence, presence, activation, existence</b>
<b>Cultural/political/social/religious movements</b>	<b>Romanticism, feminism, modernism, conservatism, republicanism, Marxism, environmentalism, Christianity, Buddhism</b>
<b>Philosophical and academic concepts</b>	<b>pathos, beauty, possibility, freedom, ethics, ontology, anachronism</b>
