Suffixes

Rules for adding -s and -es to verbs in the Present Simple:

When the verb ends in -ss, -sh, -eh, -x or -o, then we add the suffix -es.

he talk s	she eat s
dress ss	dress es
wish sh	wish es
watch ch	watch es
mix x	mix es
do o	do es

When the verb ends in a consonant + -y, we remove -y, and add the suffix -ies.

carry y	carry ies
pay y	pay s

Rules for adding -ing to verbs in continuous tenses:

When the verb ends in -e, we remove the -e and add the suffix -ing

sing	singing	drink	drinking
live	living		
use	using		

When the verb ends in -ie, we convert *ie to -y' and add the suffix -ing

tie	tying		
die	dying		

When the verb is a single syllable and ends in a consonant - vowel - consonant, we double its last letter and add the suffix -ing.

put	putting		
drop	dropping		
get	getting

When the verb ends in **consonant - vowel - consonant** and the last letter of the verb is **l**, then we **double the l** and add the suffix **-ing**.

travel	travelling
--------	------------

When the verb has two or more syllables, ends with **consonant - vowel - consonant**, and the stress is on the last syllable, we double the last letter before adding the suffix -ing.

forget	forgetting
listen	listening

Note: We do not double the last letter if the verb ends in -w, -x and -y.

destroy	destroying
---------	------------
